ACCESSIBILITY.

Hayes Station, on the Southern Electric Railway, is a short distance from Coneyhall, and there are frequent services to Charing Cross, Waterloo, Cannon Street and London Bridge. The journey to London takes 30 minutes.

The 146 bus service from Lewisham to Westerham via Bromley and Hayes passes close to the Estate.

There is a proposed bus route to pass Coneyhall which will link up with Hayes and Bromley South Stations.

Morrell's own bus service is in operation for the use of residents and visitors, free of charge. It is a 12-minute service.

SHOPPING.
