A full list of the schools in the district would take far too much space, for there are in the neighbourhood of Hayes no less than sixteen good schools of all types, while the district surrounding Beckenham is even better supplied, having besides secondary and elementary schools, many private, preparatory, technical and art schools.

PLACES OF WORSHIP.

At no distance from the Estate, stands the lovely old Parish Church, built by Sir Henry Heydon in about 1470. This church is especially notable for its seven wonderful stained glass windows dating from the 15th century, and contains much of interest to the ordinary visitor and the antiquary alike. In the vicinity are to be found places of worship for nearly all denominations.
